

Scheduling Traffic On The CTN

When someone brings traffic to the net, ask them if they wish to QTA (cancel) the traffic listing after the current net session is over or list it for more than just the current session. Tag the ones to "carry over" to the next net session; I'm using "FWD" - "forward to the next session". For the "FWD" messages, you might remind the listing station that they should try and be on the next day's net at 1800 in case someone wants to take them. If this is the first time the message(s) are appearing on the net then you can include them in your net report, added to QTC (number of messages IN); otherwise, don't include them in that count. At the end of your net session, if you have any messages marked "FWD", please send an email to ncs@califtrafficnet.com showing the next day's net (for example "For 1/5/22 - Wednesday"); the station that has the messages; and the message destinations. This allows the next day's NCS to start listing the traffic as soon as they start (1800), giving the traffic maximum exposure on the net. Our default action is still to QTA traffic at the end of a net session.
